1. ynote Speech & Special Address:

There will be keynote speech and special address by distinguished Academicians.

Technical Paper Presentation 2.

Topics: i) Innovation in Education, ii) Quality Prospects of Education, iii) TOM in Education: An Initiative to Develop Total Ouality Person, iv) Best Practice in SOC, v) Education and Peace, vi) KAIZEN applied in Education Management, vii) 5S in Education viii) The Power of Emerging Technologies

Guidelines:

i) Maximum six pages inclusive of figures, tables, pictures etc. Alphabet font size will be 12, Times New Roman. Title of the paper and headlines will be bold, font size 14. Please use A4 size paper. Headlines and sub-headlines should be chronologically numbered. ii) Name of the author should appear below the title in the right hand corner in italics, font size 12.

iii) Footnote of the first page must include the identity of the author with designation, institution etc.

iv) The abstract of technical paper (accompanied by soft copy) & 2 copy passport size photographs must reach the convener before 20 August 2023, along with a 100 words resume.

v) Each presenter will get maximum 15 minutes for presentation.

3. SOC Case Study Presentation:

Guidelines:

i) Students' teams will be classified into - a) Up to class V b) Class VI-VIII c) Class IX-XII

ii) Each team is allotted a time slot of 12 minutes for presentation excluding preparation time.

iii) A warning bell will be rung after 10 minutes and the final bell will be rung denoting the end of the presentation.

iv) Upon ringing of the final warning bell, the teams should immediately stop their presentation.

v) Maximum ten members may participate in a team/SQC.

vi) SQC must send an abstract (maximum 500 words, font: 12, New Times Roman, spacing: 1) of their case study along with 6R size group photograph latest by 20 August 2023 to the secretariat.

Award: Platinum (Marks 86 & above), Gold (Marks 70-85), Silver (Marks below 70)

4. Poster & Slogan Competition:

a. Topics: Topic for poster and slogan competition will be given based on the theme of the convention at the spot.

b. <u>Guidelines:</u> Students' teams will be classified into a) Up to class V b) Class VI-VIII c) Class IX-XII

Each team will be represented by TWO participants. The participants shall work collectively to present an attractive poster with a slogan to project the topic. Time allotted will be two hours. Participants must bring their own poster colors and brushes. At the venue the organiser will provide white card sheets (27" x 22"). Soft boards will also be provided for display. The poster will be judged on the basis of creativity, neatness, originality and interpretation of the theme. The Organizing Committee will retain posters.

Award: The top 3 Poster & Slogan will be honored with prizes.

5. Quality Quiz Competition:

Guidelines:

i) Each team will be represented by TWO participants to solve the question together.

- ii) Students' teams will be classified into a) Class VI-VIII b) Class IX-XII
- iii) Time allotted will be **one and half** hours to answer 50 questions.
- iv) No marks will be deducted for an incorrect answer or no response.

Topics: Arts and literature-10, Science and Technology-10, Mathmathitics-10, Sports and Legends- 10, IQ and Mental Ability-10 **Award: The top 3 teams will be honored with prizes.**

6. Panel Discussion:

Guidelines:

i) Panel discussion is an invitation event.

ii) Maximum TEN panelists will be invited for panel discussions from among all participating educational institutions.

iii) There will be a round of panel discussion. Topics will be given by the moderator at the time of panel discussion.


iv) The Moderator will initiate the discussion. Co-moderator will act as time keeper and rapporteur.

v) Each panelist will be given 2 minutes for presenting their opinion. The Panel discussion is planned for one and half hour with questions and responses from audience.

vi) Panelists discuss on a round robin basis first in clockwise direction, and then anticlockwise direction. Panelists will be encouraged to give their opinion randomly by raising their hand in the third round.

vii) The audience can pose questions to any panelist in the open discussion at the end of the discussion. If no question is posed from the audience, the moderator may pose the question to the panelists.

A certificate of participation will be awarded to all attendees in the convention.
