► Guidelines:

- i) Maximum six pages inclusive of figures, tables, pictures etc. Alphabet font size will be 12, Times New Roman. Title of the paper and headlines will be bold, font size 14. Please use A4 size paper. Headlines and sub-headlines should be chronologically numbered.
- ii) Name of the author should appear below the title in the right-hand corner in italics, font size 12.
- iii) Footnote of the first page must include the identity of the author with designation, institution etc.
- iv) The abstract of technical paper (accompanied by soft copy) & 2 copy passport size photographs must reach the BSTQM Secretariat before 05 November 2025, along with a 100 words resume.
- v) Each presenter will get maximum 15 minutes for presentation.



3. SQC Case Study Presentation

► Guidelines:

- i) Students' teams will be classified into - a) Up to class V b) Class VI-VIII c) Class IX-XII d) University students
- ii) Each team is allotted a time slot of 12 minutes for presentation excluding preparation time.
- iii) A warning bell will be rung after 10 minutes and the final bell will be rung denoting the end of the presentation.
- iv) Upon ringing of the final warning bell, the teams should immediately stop their presentation.
- v) Maximum ten members may participate in a team/SQC.
- vi) SQC must send an abstract (maximum 500 words, font: 12, New Times Roman, spacing: 1) of their case study along with 6R size group photograph latest by 05 November 2025 to the secretariat.

► **Guidelines:**

- i) Students' teams will be classified into a) Up to class V b) Class VI-VIII c) Class IX-XII
- ii) Each team will be represented by TWO participants. The participants shall work collectively to present an attractive poster with a slogan to project the topic. Time allotted will be two hours.
- iii) Participants must bring their own poster colors and brushes. At the venue the organiser will provide white card sheets (27" x 22").
- iv) Soft boards will also be provided for display.
- v) The poster will be judged on the basis of creativity, neatness, originality and interpretation of the theme.
- vi) The Organizing Committee will retain posters.
- vii) The mentioned four topics are for practice and among them one will be given on the spot.
